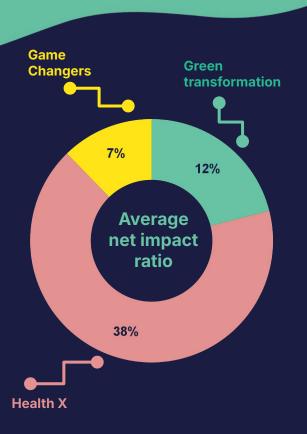

Voima Ventures invests in three investment segments, Green Transformation, in which 40% of investments are made, Health X, in which 40% of investments are made and Game Changers, in which 20% of investments are made.

Fund II has a significant amount of investments in Game Changers category, compared to Fund I and III. Investment amounts in Health X and Green Transformation correlate with the investment strategy.

Fund III has currently 12 companies while the active pipeline has dozens of cases.

Scaling net positive deep tech innovations



WHAT IS NET IMPACT RATIO AND WHY DOES IT MATTER?

Net impact ratio measures both the positive and negative impact of a company across categories, such as environment, health, society and knowledge. Net impact ratio provides a more holistic view on impact, and supports decision making and risk management.

The highest average net impact by investment category can be seen within Health X. Within the Health X category, a significant net impact can be seen with Avenue Biosciences (+74%), Sooma Medical (+74%) and Hormona (+66%), for example. This means that within the category Health X, by average, strong positive contributions to human health can be seen, while negative externalities, such as pollution, remain low.

The average ratio is lower for Green Transformation. The likely reasoning for that is that the positive impact can be seen as the companies scale. Many negative externalities might have a significant effect at the beginning states of the production, but once the company starts scaling their solution, positive impact will skyrocket. The case might be the same for category Game Changers. The average net impact ratio is still positive for both companies which means they produce more positive impact than negative.

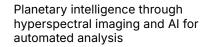

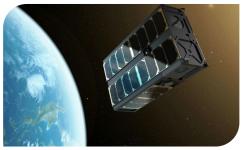

Investment and ESG Strategy at Voima Ventures

Thesis and Pre-investment

Voima Ventures Value Creation and Impact KPIs

Exit and long-term Impact

We invest in high potential deep tech companies addressing **global challenges**, related to, among others, environmental, healthcare equality, clean energy and food.

We incorporate **ESG risks** into our investment assessment and include **impact performance metrics** in our value creation framework. For Fund III investments, we are following a **binding element requirement** in order for our investments to have a net positive impact. We do not invest in companies involved in tobacco or alcohol production, weapons, gambling, human cloning or any activities related to illegal data access or pornography.

Companies with strong ESG often attract higher valuations as investors seek sustainable investments. Voima Ventures considers ESG & impact achievements when **preparing for an exit**.

We develop a **transition plan** that outlines how new owners can maintain or enhance ESG activities. This can help ensure continuity of **positive practices and mitigate potential backlash** and risks.

For **80%** of the companies in our Fund III portfolio, we will introduce **impact KPIs**. This ensures that the fund also has an impact return component, in addition to financial targets.

Portfolio companies' value creation is considered and measured from ESG point of view. Involvement of the **Board of Directors** on ESG matters, identification of key ESG opportunities and risks, and planning an exit strategy.

Division of ESG & Impact Responsibilities

The Managing Partner has ESG oversight responsibility. Niko Elers leads the impact, ESG, and responsible investment implementation for Voima Ventures' 107M Euro, Article 8-compliant Fund III, embedding these principles into the fund's processes.

Each GP manager plays a key role in driving tailored value creation plans across portfolio companies.

Voima Ventures also provides internal and external training on ESG, sustainability, impact, and diversity for its portfolio companies, supporting them in advancing their own responsible practices.

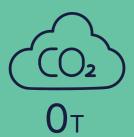

Voima Ventures is likely to join the board after making an investment. The General Partner's (GP) role is to monitor ESG in the boards by requiring annual updates on the company's ESG performance. The GP aims to assess ESG activities in strong connection with the company's growth by assessing how ESG actions and policies can support the company in growing sustainably.

Resources:

Voima Ventures provides support and resources to its companies. For Fund III companies, Voima Ventures places a binding element that guides the company towards sustainable growth through responsible operations. Voima Ventures is available for support and questions, and provides, among others, templates to portfolio companies. The purpose of the templates is to help the companies in getting started in their ESG journey.





Responsible companies lead to stable economic growth

Voima Ventures' role in responsible economic growth

According to recent literature, while ESG does not boost GDP growth immediately, but strong economic benefits are likely to occur gradually. Namely, social and governance factors can strongly influence stable economic growth in the long run. In a study examining ESG performance and economic growth in 29 OECD countries, ESG practices' role in increasing social trust and stability, reduction of long-run environmental and institutional risks, and the encouragement of long-term investment in infrastructure, health and governance is highlighted as a driver of stable economic growth.

Introduction

Fund I

Voima Ventures Fund I consists of portfolio from VTT - the National Technology Research Center of Finland. Most of the companies have been founded between 2009 - 2016, and all of them are VTT spinouts.

In 2019 Voima Ventures team started to manage the Fund I, and VTT remains the sole LP.

Originally 20+ and today 7 active companies in the portfolio can be categorized in to green transition, health tech and game changer -domains which are the focus areas of the Voima Ventures Fund III.

Particularly the companies that we expect to return significantly are contributing substantially in to SDG related to either the environment or health. This gives us fair confidence that companies in Funds II & III with meaningful impact contribution are likely to return more to the fund when compared to portfolio companies with little impact.

Key findings

Fund I companies measured are showcasing solid progress within ESG areas. All companies measured cover governance- and social sustainability-related policies in some way. These policies might be covered in their own handbooks or in other internal processes. The fact that the amount of diversity related policies has gone down likely indicates the informality of such policy.

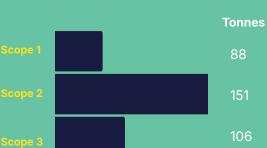

In spite of the globally difficult economic situation, our companies in Fund I have made significant key recruitments, ending up creating jobs even when a few companies have been forced to wind down operations. Meanwhile, Solar Foods conducted a technical listing on the OMXH First North list and which indicated a significant jump in operational maturity from startup to a public company.

Key findings

All companies have either an anonymous or non-anonymous whistleblower channel. The global uncertainties have increased the significance of proper supply chain assessment. Thus, we are happy to report that a majority of our portfolio companies consider supply chain risk assessment and responsible procurement policies.

Introduction

Fund II

Launched in 2019, Voima Ventures Fund II is a 45m€ fund (with 15M € top-up) is the first 100% deep technology focussed fund in the Nordics with a focus on university and research center spinouts. The strategy of the Fund II is to invest into the best Nordic research teams working on scalable solutions.

Fund II portfolio consists of 23 companies (vintage 2019-2023) and is now focussed on follow-on investments and value creation of the existing portfolio.

Anchor LPs of the Fund are VTT, European Investment Fund EIF, and Finnish family offices and the University of Jyväskylä.

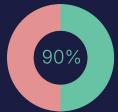
Invested capital towards Health X and Game changers

As we can see in the case of Fund II, some policies measured in amounts implemented, have decreased compared to the previous year. Up on discussions with Fund II CEOs, most companies have internal policies covering ESG topics, but the policies go by a different name compared to Voima Ventures' survey. Overall, the CEOs discussed presented good awareness on ESG topics, with internal policies covering them.

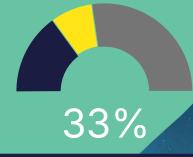
The companies measured for Fund II showcase gradual growth as a fund with 84 people employed in the last 12 months. Fund II companies are well prepared for ESG-related risks as there was no ESG incidents reported last year among the measured companies. Many companies are in a great trajectory of reaching a sufficient level of ESG maturity.

Key findings

Fund II has a positive net impact of 49%. The impact this thus strong and significantly above the average. Thus, more benefit than harm is created for every dollar invested. We want to highlight the net impact ratio among the ESG metrics presented, because there is a large-impact happening as a result of our portfolio companies' operations, not placing emphasis on ESG-related metrics and policies necessarily.

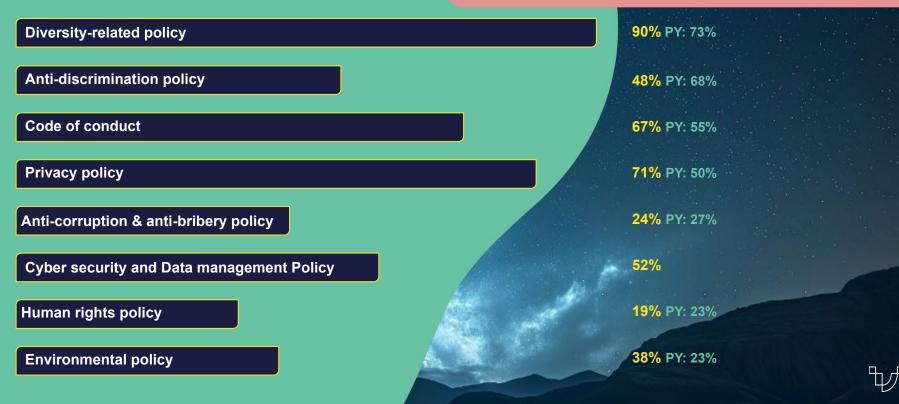
Key findings

Similarly to measured companies in Fund I, most companies in Fund II have either an anonymous whistleblower channel or a non-anonymous one, or another procedure covering the same purpose. The share of female and non-binary employees have stayed roughly the same compared to the previous year, while supply chain risk assessment metric has decreased. As mentioned, most measured companies conduct responsible procurement and supply chain measures internally.

Key findings

The percentage of companies that have a diversity-related policies has increased. This year, we formulated the question slightly differently compared to the previous year. Thus, there are notable differences in the way companies interpret the question. Therefore, as mentioned previously, most companies do cover diversity-related policies in their own processes in some way, and we include that in the reporting.

Introduction

Fund III

Voima Ventures Fund III is a 107m€ article 8 fund. The Fund focuses primarily to Nordic and Baltic region (selectively rest of EU), and seeks to build a portfolio of total 25 - 30 companies with high growth potential and strong scientific foundation. In total, the Fund has 40% of its investment capacity to use towards companies in green transformation and 40% towards companies contributing to better health. 20% is reserved for a category of game changers. All investments must pass the binding elements as defined in the SFDR annex.

The fund also looks to quantify the investment impact by attributing a impact KPI for 80% of the companies in the portfolio that will be tracked and reported yearly. The target is to create a impactful portfolio that is able to draw on the very best and the brightest local minds to create measurable outcomes. In the survey period of this report, the fund has made 8 investment of which 4 are contributing towards green transformation and 4 for better health of mankind.

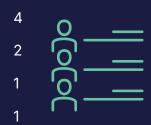
Fund III is still on early stages. ÄlÖ and Sooma, for example, are operational while Liquid Sun, for example is still in tech development stages. All of the current companies are under the requirement to set up and track business specific impact KPI's. As mentioned last year, our initial data analysis provided by our impact data partner Upright suggests that investing a dollar into Voima Ventures Fund III portfolio has a significant impact compared to holding it as cash or investing in to a index of fortune 500 companies

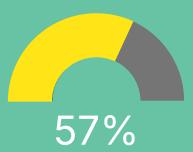


Fund III Companies with Board Committed to ESG Discussions (%)

Key findings

We have seen solid improvement within the whistleblower channels compared to the previous year. Nevertheless, while Voima Ventures provides resources in implementing such procedures, monitoring of these policies are also crucial. For very early-stage companies, such as companies Fund III, implementing the policies presented mitigates risks and conflicts within the company from early on.

How Voima Ventures sees the impact:

Avenue Biosciences is addressing one of biotechnology's most pressing issues: the lack of efficient and scalable protein production. This bottleneck slows development and delivery of life-saving therapies, such as monoclonal antibodies, mRNA vaccines and gene therapies.

The societal benefit of Avenue Biosciences is far-reaching. It reduces development time and cost for advanced biologics, makes critical therapies more accessible globally, and strengthens the scalability of biopharmaceutical manufacturing which might be essential in addressing future health crisis.

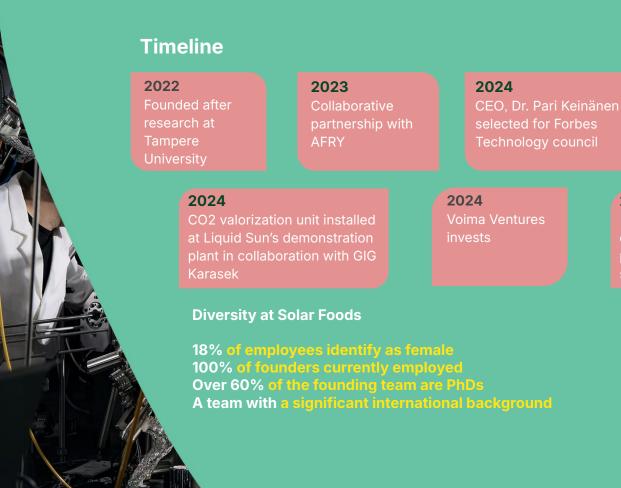

Aisti's first commercial plant is in Kitee, where their first product, biobased building material solution, Aisti Teno, is produced.

As buildings are responsible for 39% of global energy-related carbon emissions, Aisti's impact has the potential to be far-reaching.

Aisti is not only creating sustainable products but their first factory will run on renewable energy. Aisti's products are widely tested to have excellent qualities, including the improvement of air quality. Additionally, they are cost competitive to other alternatives in the market. Aisti represents a significant step towards mass production of fully sustainable alternatives in the construction industry that can compete with traditional alternatives in terms of product qualities and price.

The tracking is Al-driven and provides an accuracy of over 90%. The software provides personalized recommendations, symptoms tracking and educational content.

Why are critical conditions, affecting half of the world's population, so under-researched? Particularly, the conditions Hormona's at-home test is tracking, are heavily under-research and underserved. There is a systematic data gap in medicine regarding women's health.

80% of women experience hormone-related symptoms. Hormona's biometrics and Al solution deliver personalized and predictive healthcare at scale. The innovation is backed by medical experts and clinically validated, putting an end to guesswork when it comes to women's healthcare.

Glossary

Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG): A framework used in understanding risks and opportunities around environmental, social and governance related areas.

Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): Adopted by the United Nations in 2015, the SDGs are an outline to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all. The SDGs can be adopted by companies to align business sustainability goals with society's goals.

Greenhouse Gas Emissions: Carbon dioxide (CO2) makes up the majority greenhouse gas emissions alongside smaller amounts of methane (CH4) and nitrous oxide (N2O). Greenhouse gases trap heat and make the planet warmer, resulting largely from human activities.

ESG Maturity: ESG maturity is used for assessing companies' progress in integrating ESG factors into their business practices. Voima Ventures assess its portfolio companies' ESG maturity on five levels, one being the lowest and five being the highest.

Code of Conduct: Outlines expected behaviors, rules and principles to be followed by employees and those associated with the company.

Anti-Discrimination Policy: Ensures a safe and inclusive environment for all employees with guidelines to prevent discrimination of protected characteristics.

Anti-Corruption and Anti-Bribery Policy: Ensures companies' commitment to operating in an ethical manner with applicable anti-bribery laws.

Good Governance Policy: Ensures transparency, integrity and lawfulness of companies.

Privacy Policy: Guides companies on the collection, using, storing, disclosing and protecting the personal information of former, current and prospective employees and customers.

Sustainable and Environmental Policy: Actions plans aimed to protect the natural and environment and enhance sustainable practices. Companies' actions to increase the planet ecosystem's health.

Human Rights Policy: Companies' commitment to respecting, protecting and enforcing human rights.

Net Impact: The net sum of costs and benefits, also referred to as negative and positive impact, that the company creates. Externalities are included.

PAI indicators: Principle Adverse Impact indicator is a metric used to measure a financial investments' negative effects on ESG factors. It was developed by the European Union as a part of the Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation (SDFR). Voima Ventures' Fund III is an Article 8 Fund.

As a venture capital fund investing in early-stage growth companies, we expect absolute GHG emissions to increase as our portfolio companies expand operations. Our actions therefore focus on managing emissions intensity and embedding climate-conscious governance structures early, to ensure that growth is sustainable.

Appendix & AssumptionsVoima Ventures' internal GHG calculations

Voima Ventures internal scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse gas emissions are calculated with OpenOcean template as well as with a carbontech company's demo GHG emissions calculation spreadsheet. The calculations are from 2024.

OpenOcean offers greenhouse gas emission calculators to help companies measure and manage their carbon footprint. Voima Ventures uses OpenOcean in order to gain accurate and transparent data calculated by an external operator. All data sources are chosen on the basis of receiving the most up to date sources for the GHG emissions. Data sources chosen can represent as accurate as possible estimate of the true emissions.



Appendix & Assumptions Portfolio Results

The Upright Project is used for portfolio companies' emissions and SDG and EU taxonomy alignment. The Upright Project is a platform that quantifies the impact of companies and, therefore, enables smarter decision-making for companies.

ESG survey is used for gathering data on portfolio companies. The survey is conducted at the end of the spring of 2025. Results, such as, "Number of new hires" or "Share of female employees" are from the year 2024. As the results were gathered in the Spring of 2025, questions, such as "Does the company have a code of conduct", are based on the current status of the company, which is not expected to change rapidly, exceptions considered.

Certain companies are excluded from the emissions calculations as well as from the ESG survey results. The selected group of companies is aimed to showcase accurate data and information of that specific fund.
